The Problem

The utility giant needed to access a range of terrains in urban and rural locations with a trailer that could be attached to an existing fleet of fire fighting vehicles as a quick response to small fires during onsite repairs.



The Solution

Coerco custom-designed and fabricated a steel chassis and axle trailer to suit a water tank that's orientated to fit onto a narrower chassis with a pump and a hose reel.



The design incorporates a tandem axle that has been designed to maximise stability and weight distribution for easy access to differing terrains like sand and gravel, and easy maneuverability in urban areas.
